Marina Fire Training Drills

June 22 & 29

The Timberlake Fire Protection District will be conducting training exercises for marina fires on Monday, June 22 and Monday, June 29 from 6:30 PM to 9:00 PM. The exercises will take place at Scenic Bay Marina on C-Dock.

Non-toxic fire training smoke will be visible through the use of a smoke machine. There will be no live fire or flames used in the exercise. The smoke will simulate a fire in the floating home of Mike and Laura Whitby at Slip #20.

Other information:

- Other agencies and boats may be involved.
- Fire hose will be laid down C-Dock, uncharged on the 22nd and charged with water on the 29th.
- We will flow water on June 29 only and a hose will be connected to the fire hydrant at the intersection of Pier Road and Limekiln Road. Pier Road may be partially blocked during the drill.
- Fire trucks and the fire boat may have their emergency lights flashing on June 29.

We appreciate your cooperation in maintaining a safe distance from the training exercise and keeping away from any charged fire hoses. This type of training is critical to the safety of the firefighters in the event of a marina fire. This will also allow us to practice the tactics needed to successfully contain and extinguish a boat or structure fire in a marina, effectively rescue and evacuate occupants from the docks, and proficiently coordinate with other agencies and boaters.
